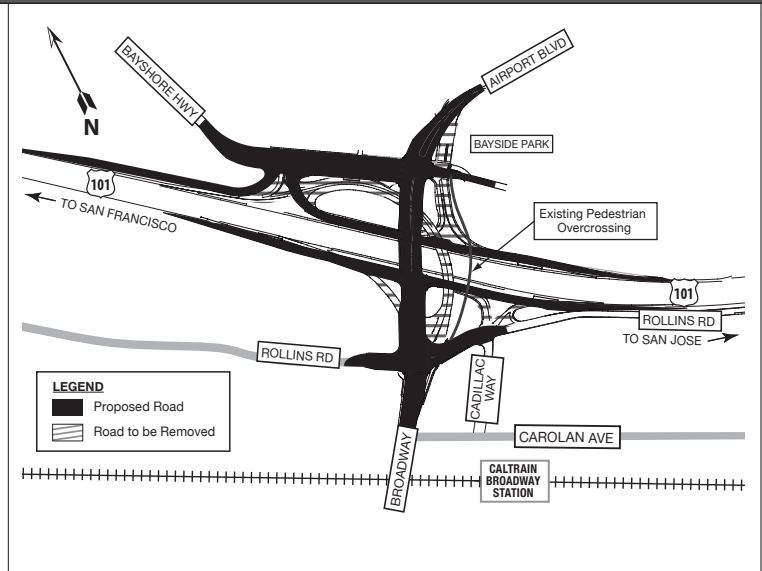


# US 101/Broadway Interchange Reconstruction Project

## NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF THE INITIAL STUDY WITH PROPOSED MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION/ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT AND PUBLIC MEETING FOR THE US 101/BROADWAY INTERCHANGE RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

### WHY THIS NOTICE

Pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), in cooperation with the San Mateo County Transportation Authority (TA) and the City of Burlingame, has studied the environmental impacts of this project. These studies show that with the incorporation of mitigation measures, the proposed project will not significantly affect the quality of the environment. The document that explains this conclusion is called an Initial Study with Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration/Environmental Assessment (IS/EA). This notice is to inform you that the IS/EA is available for a 30-day public review period from August 30 to September 29, 2010. A public meeting is scheduled on September 15, 2010 to accept public comments on the IS/EA.



# US 101/Broadway Interchange Reconstruction Project

## WHAT'S BEING PLANNED

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), in cooperation with the San Mateo County Transportation Authority (TA) and the City of Burlingame, proposes to reconfigure the US 101/Broadway Interchange in the City of Burlingame, County of San Mateo, California.

The proposed project would remove the existing four-lane Broadway overcrossing and construct a new seven-lane overcrossing approximately 170 feet to the north of the existing structure. Broadway would be realigned to extend straight across US 101 from the Broadway/Rollins Road intersection on the west to the Bayshore Highway/Airport Boulevard intersection on the east.

The purpose of this project is to improve traffic movements and access around the interchange, accommodate future traffic increases at adjacent intersections, improve operations at the southbound US 101 ramps, and increase bicyclist and pedestrian access.

Other improvements include replacing the existing on- and off-ramps, and installing ramp metering equipment. The project would retain the existing pedestrian overcrossing just south of Broadway and provide additional pedestrian and bicycle improvements at the interchange.
