Thank you very much for taking the time to contact us regarding our *Reimagine SamTrans* project. We appreciate your feedback and suggestions related to Route 260 and bus service to the residents in the Redwood Shores Community.

We will be sure to take these comments and suggestions for additional service into careful consideration as we finalize the bus network.

Following a review of the feedback received during this latest round of outreach, final network recommendations (which will include an associated Title VI analysis and environmental impact findings) will be presented for adoption by the SamTrans Board of Directors in February or March of 2022.

Implementation of the new network is currently slated to begin in August 2022.

While incorporating On-Demand/FLEX service in Redwood Shores is not currently included in the recommended network, we will be continuously reviewing the network and travel needs throughout the county. We encourage you to remain engaged with project staff as we work toward implementation of the new bus network.

Progress toward autonomous personal and share autonomous transit vehicles (AV/SAV) has been steadily increasing over the past decade. However, most of the research and communications about the technology has been centered on how vehicles themselves adapt to the environment around it, rather than how cities should be preparing for the transition to a future that may include connected transit, autonomous shuttles, and driverless cars.

This virtual workshop, aimed at better understanding how autonomous technologies may impact travel and mobility in San Mateo County, will provide an overview of the current policy framework in California and beyond, and discuss current autonomous and connected vehicle technologies for personal, shared, and transit vehicle applications.
