
Today the American Lung Association reported that air pollution in the Bay Area is among the worst in the nation:

According to the report, "The combined readings for San Francisco, San Jose and Oakland ranked 12th worst for high ozone days, 7th worst for 24-hour particle pollution and fifth worst for annual particle pollution out of the over 200 metropolitan areas of the United State measured in the report."
