JOHN DALY BLVD/SKYLINE BLVD PEDESTRIAN CONNECTION PROJECT**

The project is located at the west end of John Daly Blvd, which terminates at Skyline Blvd. The west leg of the intersection ends in a parking lot for Thornton State Beach. Currently, the sidewalk on the north side of John Day Blvd ends approximately 1400 ft. east of Skyline Blvd (just west of Eastgate Dr.) at the SamTrans bus stop.

The project will construct a sidewalk on the north side of John Daly Boulevard between Eastgate Drive and Skyline Boulevard to provide a pedestrian connection between the Westlake neighborhood and activity centers west of Skyline Boulevard. It will also install pedestrian-scale lighting along the sidewalk and construct an ADA-compliant curb ramp at the west end of the sidewalk.


