Program Overview

- San Mateo County Shuttle Program: Joint TA & C/CAG Call for Projects
 - TA Measure A Local Shuttle Program
 - C/CAG Local Transportation Services Shuttle Program
- Program purpose: provide matching funding for the operation of local shuttle services
- Eligible costs include operations, marketing & administration of shuttles



Eligibility Requirements

- Sponsor must be a public agency
- Serves county residents & employees
- Provides access to regional transit and/or meets local mobility needs
- Open to public & ADA compliant
- Funds are to supplement, not supplant other funding sources
- SamTrans concurrence letter required
- Governing board resolution required



Process: Funding & Evaluation

- Joint Call for Projects was issued
 December 14, 2015
 - Covers Fiscal Years 2017 & 2018
 Up to \$9.0 million from TA Measure A
 Up to \$1.0 million from C/CAG
 Up to \$10.0 million total funds available
- Minimum 25% match required
- One application process, one staff
 evaluation panel

Effectiveness	Annual operating cost/passenger for past 12 months (FY2015) for existing shuttles, or projected if new
Existing shuttles – 25%	shuttles
New shuttles – 15%	 Annual passengers/service hour for past 12 months (FY2015) for existing shuttles, or projected if new shuttles
	 Shuttle links w/ other fixed route transit (more points for higher ridership routes)
	Improves access from TOD to major activity centers
	Reduces single occupant vehicle trips
	& vehicle miles traveled

Evaluation Criteria: Funding Leverage

Prioritization Criteria	Detailed
Category	Criteria
Funding Leverage – 20%	 Percentage of matching funds contribution: >25% to <50% up to 10 pts 50% to <75% up to 15 pts 75% to <100% up to 18 pts Extra 2 pts for private sector funding, less public subsidy

Sustainability – 15%	area, county or regional plan
	Supports jobs & housing growth/economic

	Use of clean fuel vehicle(s) for service
	Accommodation for bicycles
	Demonstration of cost savings



Summary of Changes For This Call for Projects

Required sponsor consultation with SamTrans prior to submittal of applications for new shuttles, as well as existing shuttles that don't meet the established benchmarks

	Operating	Passengers/
Service Type	Cost/Passenger	Service Hour
Commuter	\$7	15
Community or		
combination	\$9	10
Door to Door	\$18	2



Changes for Consideration with Future Call for Projects

- For future cycles, propose increasing match requirement for existing shuttles that don't meet the operating cost/passenger benchmark, up to a maximum of 50%, to help pay for costs above the benchmark
- Match requirement based on FY2017 performance, effective for funding cycle covering FY2019 & FY2020
