



# **Program Overview**

- 15% of Measure A Program
- Purpose of program is to improve safety at railroad crossing and relieve traffic congestion
- Projects include construction/upgrade of underpasses or overpasses at key road crossings along the Caltrain and Dumbarton rail lines.









# Guiding Principles: Programming & Allocation

- Design
  - Complete design with Caltrain to ensure railroad design standards are met
  - Have City Council approval and Caltrain concurrence with the selected alternative
- Construction
  - Constructed by Caltrain
  - Have full funding plan
  - Have City Council approval and Caltrain concurrence with the selected alternative ,
