Project: 25th Ave. Grade Separation

Phase: Construction

· Cost Estimate: \$165.3 mil

Measure A request: \$ 65.3 mil.

State High Speed Rail Authority: \$ 84.0 mil.

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Project Scope

- Construct Grade Separation at 25th Avenue, along with elevated rail between Hillsdale and Highway 92
- Relocate Hillsdale Station and provide station access and parking
- Construct East-West connections at 28th and 31st Avenues

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Cost Estimate by Element

 Grade Separation at 25th Ave., Elevated rail \$134.0 mil. from Hillsdale Ave. to Highway 92

Relocated Elevated Hillsdale Station
 (including Station Access and Parking)
 \$33.8 mil.

• East-West Connections at 28th and 31st Avenues \$12.2 mil.

Total \$180.0 mil.

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Cost Estimate by Phase

Prelim. Engineering & Environmental Review \$3.5 mil.

Final Design \$7.2 mil.

Right-of-Way Acquisition & Utility Relocation \$4.0 mil.¹

• Construction \$165.3 mil.

Total \$180.0 mil.

 Right-of-Way costs do not include the value of approximately 4 acres of TA owned land needed for the project that is in the process of being appraised.

• PE/ENV¹: July 2014 – Aug. 2016

Final Design & ROW²:Dec. 2015 – July 2017

Bid & Award: Nov. 2016 – April 2017

Construction: May 2017 – Oct. 2019

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Coordination with Electrification

- Electrification construction to start Spring 2017
- San Mateo needs to secure construction funds now to begin construction by mid-2017
- Construction of grade separation needs to start by mid-2017 to be completed before the installation of the Electrification Overhead Contact System

- \$1.2 mil of cost savings from \$4.7 mil. allocated to the environmental phase is proposed to be re-programmed and re-allocated to the design & right of way phases of work.

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Special Circumstance Considerations

- Urgency
 - √ Significant cost savings
 - √ Safety improvement
 - √ Potential loss of funds
- · Impact to Measure A program
 - ✓ Grade Separation Program balance through FY2017: \$ 36.5 mil
 - ✓ Annual receipts approximately \$12 mil.
 - ✓ Staff currently evaluating whether funds can be borrowed from other TA programs, if needed to cash flow project



Schedule

- August 2016:
 - San Mateo submits letter requesting Measure A construction allocation
 - State High Speed Rail Authority authorizes MOU for \$84 mil. to project
- September 2016:
 - Information item on 25th Avenue Grade Separation
- October 2016:
 - TA action on 25th Avenue Grade Separation funding request
