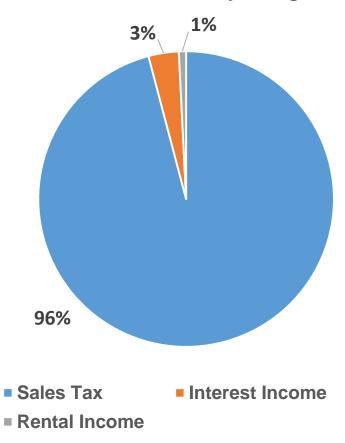

Percent of Total Revenue for FY2022 Preliminary Budget

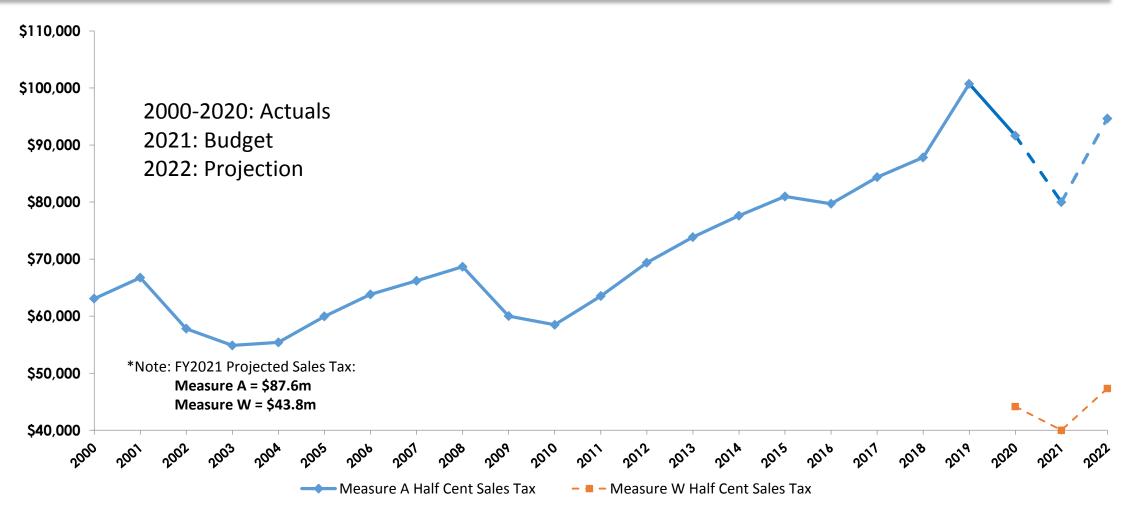

Measure A & W Sales Tax

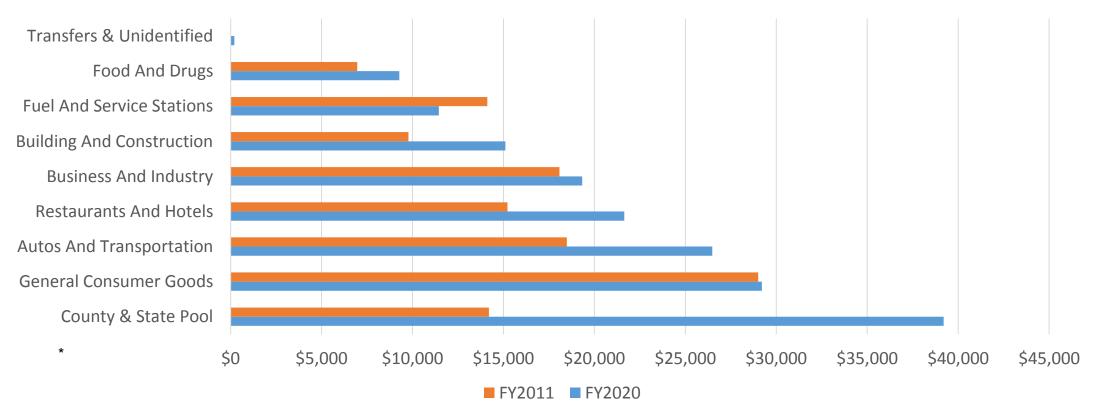

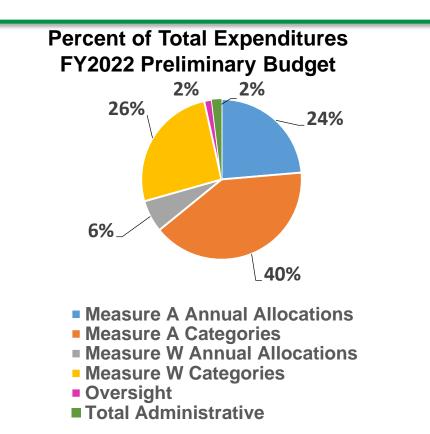

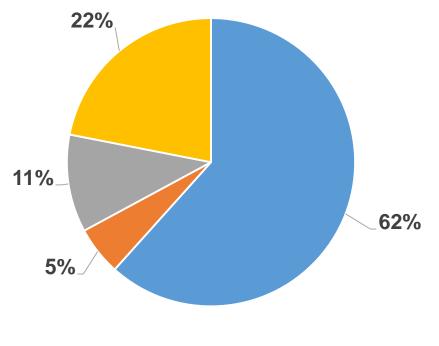

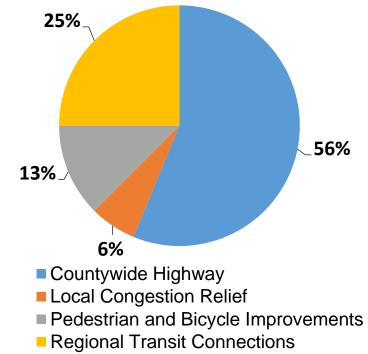
